Excess Volunteers: Having too many volunteers, particularly from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM, led to inefficiencies, with 4-5 volunteers being underutilized. Future events should aim to have fewer volunteers, on shorter shifts, to prevent overcrowding and ensure everyone is actively engaged.

Start:

Rotary Handouts: There is an opportunity to enhance the Rotary's visibility by providing flyers and handouts about the organization and its upcoming events. This would improve community engagement and help attract more participants to future Rotary activities.

The 2024 Paint Reclamation Project was a resounding success, both financially and operationally. The event demonstrated the power of streamlined coordination, low-cost operations, and effective community engagement.
